- CATEGORIES:** The following Categories are to be held:
 - Pre-Star Spin, Spiral, Jump, Creative Event
 - Star 1 Elements Event
 - Star 2 & 3 Freeskate Events
 - Star 1-3 TEAM Events
- ENTRY FEES:**
 - Pre-Star Spin, Spiral, Jump Creative: \$65.00
 - Star 1 Elements Event: \$80.00
 - Star 2 & 3 Freeskate Events: \$80.00
 - Star 1-3 TEAM EVENTS: \$55.00 / Team
- EVENT SCHEDULE:** The schedule will be posted and sent to all participants once finalized.
- ENTRIES:** Must be registrants of Skate Canada in good standing.
- CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES:** All entries must be registered online no later than midnight on **November 15, 2024**. It is the responsibility of the skater to ensure that their entry is in to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date.
- LATE ENTRIES:** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Host Committee and if space permits.
- REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:** ***NO refunds will be made after the closing date.*** Entry fees shall be refunded *only* if the event is not held.
- ON-SITE REGISTRATION:** Skaters must register at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled Category. Skaters must report to the Ice Captain 30 minutes prior to their scheduled Category. All music will be played digitally by iPod or MP3 player and must be submitted at time of registration.
- SCHEDULE AND CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:** The host club reserves the right to cancel events or limit the number of entries due to time constraints or ice availability.
- WARM UP TIMES:** Skate Canada has standardized warm up times for all events.
- AWARDS:** Ribbons and award sheets will be presented on-site at the event.
- ACCIDENTS:** The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. STARSKATE FREESKATE EVENTS

PRE-STAR SPIN, SPIRAL, JUMP CREATIVE EVENT

For skater(s) who have not passed any Star tests

Skaters will hear a piece of music selected by the host club twice in warm-up. They will then perform their trained creative routine to the music selection. Routine music is 1:30min in length.

- A Jump of any nature
- A Spin of any nature
- A Spiral of any nature
- Skating skills
- Performance

STAR 1 ELEMENTS

Skaters will perform the following skills and will be assessed accordingly. Skaters will be on the ice with a Coach to build confidence and sureness in their performance.

- Circle Stroking
- Waltz Jump
- Salchow Jump
- Toe Loop Jump
- Forward Upright Spin
- Backward Upright Spin
- Forward Spiral Circles
- Creative Expression Routine

STAR 2 FREESKATE PROGRAM

Skaters will perform their trained Star 2 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 2 Freeskate programs.

Program music must be submitted at the time of registration.

STAR 3 FREESKATE PROGRAM

Skaters will perform their trained Star 3 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 3 Freeskate programs.

Program and program music must be submitted at the time of registration.

STARSKATE TEAM EVENTS

Team Events are an opportunity for groups of up to four skaters (and minimum of two skaters) to perform together in a fun atmosphere. Skaters will each perform one Freeskate element and will contribute to an overall team assessment. Elements will be performed in the order listed. Please reach out to your skaters' coach if you need to find a team to join.

STAR 3 TEAM

Star 3 Team Elements

- Flip Jump
- Loop/Loop Combination
- Combination Spin
- Forward Spiral Sequence
